## ORDER SETTING SANCTIONS FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS OF WYOMING RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE (W.R.A.P.)

**THIS MATTER** came before the Court upon its own motion to set the following sanction fees for failure to comply with requirements of the Wyoming Rules of Appellate Procedure (W.R.A.P.). It is, therefore,

ORDERED the following sanctions are hereby set:

- 1. \$150.00 shall be imposed for failing to provide a copy of the Notice of Appeal, as described by W.R.A.P. 2.07, with the Clerk of the Supreme Court, simultaneous with the notice being filed with the trial court;
- 2. \$50.00 shall be imposed for failing to provide a Notice of Appeal that complies with W.R.A.P. 2.07(b);
- 3. \$50.00 shall be imposed for failing to provide the original and six copies of the electronically filed document within three days of filing, as described by W.R.A.P.1.01(c);
- 4. \$50.00 shall be imposed for failing to file with the District Court a designation of record that complies with W.R.A.P. 3.05; and it is further
