## **Rules for Fees and Costs for Circuit Courts**

## Rule 1. Costs and fees in criminal actions.

(a) Circuit courts shall collect <u>costs in the sum of \$20.00</u> for every criminal/traffic case for which a conviction results, unless otherwise specifically excepted by statute or court rule, <u>which</u> costs in the sum of \$20.00 which shall be assessed as part of the sentence. In addition, for every criminal/traffic case for which a conviction results, unless otherwise specifically excepted by statute or court rule, a fee of \$35.00-50.00 shall be imposed, \$25.00 Of this amount, \$40.00 of which shall be deposited into the judicial systems automation account established by W.S. § 5-2-120, and \$10.00 of which shall be deposited into the indigent civil legal services account established by § 5-2-121.
