## ORDER RESCINDING ORDER SETTING APPELLATE FILING AND DOCKETING FEES IN THE DISTRICT COURTS, CIRCUIT COURTS AND MUNICIPAL COURTS

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**THIS MATTER** came before the Court upon its own motion in consideration of this Court's Nunc Pro Tunc General Order 19-1, entered on June 28, 2019, and in further consideration of the need to simplify orders addressing the uniform filing and docketing fees for various appellate filings, other than those filed in the Supreme Court. The Court finds that such uniform fees are adequately set forth in Rules for Fees and Costs For District Courts, Rules for Fees and Costs for Circuit Courts, Rules for Fees and Costs for Municipal Courts and statute. It is therefore

**ORDERED** that effective July 1, 2020, Nunc Pro Tunc General Order 19-1 is vacated in its entirety; and it is
