### **Rules for Fees and Costs for Circuit Courts**

#### Rule 1. Costs and Fees in Criminal Actions.

(a) Circuit courts shall collect costs in the sum of \$20.00 for every eriminal/traffie misdemeanor case wherein the defendant is found guilty, enters a plea of guilty or no contest or is placed on probation as part of a deferral process for which a conviction results, unless otherwise specifically excepted by statute or court rule, which costs shall be assessed as part of the sentence. In addition, for every eriminal/traffie misdemeanor case wherein the defendant is found guilty, enters a plea of guilty or no contest or is placed on probation as part of a deferral process for which a conviction results, unless otherwise specifically excepted by statute or court rule, which costs shall be assessed as part of the sentence. In addition, for every eriminal/traffie misdemeanor case wherein the defendant is found guilty, enters a plea of guilty or no contest or is placed on probation as part of a deferral process for which a conviction results, unless otherwise specifically excepted by statute or court rule, a fee of \$50.00 shall be imposed. Of this amount, \$40.00 shall be deposited into the judicial systems automation account established by W.S. § 5-2-120, and \$10.00 shall be deposited into the indigent civil legal services account established by W.S. § 5-2-121.
