Rules for Fees and Costs for CircuitCounty Courts

Rule 1. Costs and fees in criminal actions.

CircuitCounty courts shall collect for every criminal case costs in the sum of \$20.00 which shall be assessed as part of the sentence. In addition, in each criminal action, a fee of \$10.00 shall be imposed and shall be deposited into the judicial systems automation account established by W.S. § 5-2-120.

Rule 2. Fee for record check.

The fee for checking a circuitcounty court record shall be ~~\$5.00~~ five dollars (\$5.00). All requests for a record check shall be submitted in writing by the applicant. No charge shall be made for checking circuitcounty court records if requested by an employee or representative of a governmental agency. Nor shall any charge be made by the court for responding to inquiries for information from the general public, including representatives from the news media.

Response to the request for a record check shall be made by the circuitcounty court in writing within two (2) days after the written request is submitted to the court. Payment of the \$5.00 fee for each record check shall be made in cash or check payable to the circuitcounty court.

This rule and the charge provided only applies to services required from court personnel to check and/or abstract court records. The rule has no application to the personal examination of any court records including indexes by any individual desiring information from these public records.
