JUDICIAL NOMINATING COMMISSION ANNOUNCES VACANCY IN CIRCUIT COURT, SIXTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (CROOK AND WESTON COUNTIES)

Wyoming Supreme Court Chief Justice Kate M. Fox, who acts as Chairman of the Judicial Nominating Commission, announced today that the Honorable Judge Matthew F.G. Castano, Sixth Judicial District (Crook and Weston Counties), has been appointed to the District Court, Sixth Judicial District.

The Judicial Nominating Commission will accept expressions of interest from qualified persons to fill the vacancy through, March 3, 2022. The expression of interest form can be obtained from the Supreme Court's website, http://www.courts.state.wy.us/Administration/Careers. The completed form *must be received* in the office of Chief Justice Fox no later than 5:00 p.m., on March 3, 2022. Please do not submit letters of recommendation, as the Commission will not consider them, but will instead only review documents specifically required by the expression of interest.

Governor Mark Gordon will appoint the Sixth Judicial District Circuit Court Judge (Crook and Weston Counties) from a list of three names submitted to him by the Judicial Nominating Commission. Serving on the Judicial Nominating Commission are Chief Justice Fox, three lawyers elected by the Wyoming State Bar: Anna Reeves Olson of Casper, Katherine Strike of Lander, and Devon O'Connell of Laramie; and three non-lawyers appointed by the Governor: Gudrid Espenscheid of Big Piney, Paul Scherbel of Afton, and Dan Kirkbride of Chugwater.

The salary for the Circuit Court judge position is \$145,000 per year, with State insurance benefits, Wyoming Retirement 457 plan https://retirement.wyo.gov/en/DC, and a generous judicial pension. Wyo. Stat. § 5-1-106.

TO SERVE AS A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE, ONE MUST BE A QUALIFIED ELECTOR OF THE STATE, AND AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE LAW IN WYOMING.
